The core SVI instructional program consists of four hours a day of classes from Monday to Friday inclusive. The mini-institute program consists of only two hours a day of classes. It is intended primarily for the younger siblings of fully-enrolled students, who may not have the stamina or attention span for the full program. Enrolment is limited.

The Advanced Chamber Music program begins two days earlier than the regular SVI, on Friday evening. It is intended for advanced students with considerable previous chamber music experience who are looking for a more intensive program and are capable of some self-direction. A teacher recommendation form is required (see website). Enrolment is limited and contingent on instrumentation.
